Equipment

Activity

- 1 Draw a large fruit tree on a piece of cardboard. Stick this on a wall.
- 2 Give the children a variety of craft materials and ask them to create different fruits to hang off the tree.
- 3 Stick the children's fruit creations onto the fruit tree.
- 4 Display the fruit tree where everyone can see it.
